### QS World University Rankings 2026: NYCU Ranks 199th Globally, Entering the Top 200 for the First Time!

On June 19, 2025, Quacquarelli Symonds (QS), the renowned British higher education analytics organization, released the 2026 QS World University Rankings. Taiwan had three universities ranked within the top 200 globally, marking a significant improvement compared to the previous year. In addition to National Taiwan University ranking 63rd globally, National Tsing Hua University (176th) and National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (NYCU, 199th) were also featured prominently. Notably, this marks the first time NYCU has broken into the global top 200, signaling promising future development.

In the 2026 QS rankings, NYCU significantly improved across all evaluated indicators, increasing its overall score from 43.9 to 55.7 points—an impressive growth of 11.8 points. Among these indicators, "Sustainability" showed the most substantial improvement, rising by 35.3 points, demonstrating NYCU's outstanding achievements in sustainable development and governance. Additionally, notable enhancements were observed in "Citations per Faculty" and "Employment Outcomes," with increases of 19.1 and 17.5 points, respectively. These achievements highlight the university's growing international reputation in research impact and the career performance of its graduates.



## THE Impact Rankings 2025 : NYCU Achieves Best-Ever Result with a Global Ranking of 41st!

On June 18, 2025, Times Higher Education (THE), a prestigious British higher education institution, released its 2025 University Impact Rankings. National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (NYCU) achieved an outstanding global ranking of 41st, marking its highest ranking ever. This achievement not only secures the university's position in the global top 100 for three consecutive years but also highlights NYCU's excellence in driving sustainable development and expanding its global influence.



A total of 2,318 universities worldwide participated in this year's rankings. NYCU participated in 11 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), seven of which ranked within the global top 100, demonstrating exceptional achievements in interdisciplinary integration, sustainable governance, and social engagement. The detailed rankings for NYCU are as follows:

- SDG 16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions 10th globally
- SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being 20th globally
- SDG 2: Zero Hunger 22nd globally
- SDG 7: Affordable and Clean Energy 27th globally
- SDG 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities 39th globally
- SDG 9: Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure 41st globally
- SDG 12: Responsible Consumption and Production 65th globally

## U.S. News 2025-2026 Best Global Universities Rankings: NYCU Ranks 625th Globally!

On June 17, 2025, U.S. News & World Report announced its 2025-2026 Best Global Universities Rankings. National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (NYCU) ranked 625th globally, 178th in Asia, and 5th within Taiwan. This year, NYCU was ranked in 25 subjects, with 11 subjects showing improvement compared to last year. The university achieved the top national ranking in "Cardiac and Cardiovascular Systems" and "Optics," while "Endocrinology and Metabolism" entered the rankings for the first time.

#### Purpose of the Competition:


